

# Connecting your School Device to Wi-Fi

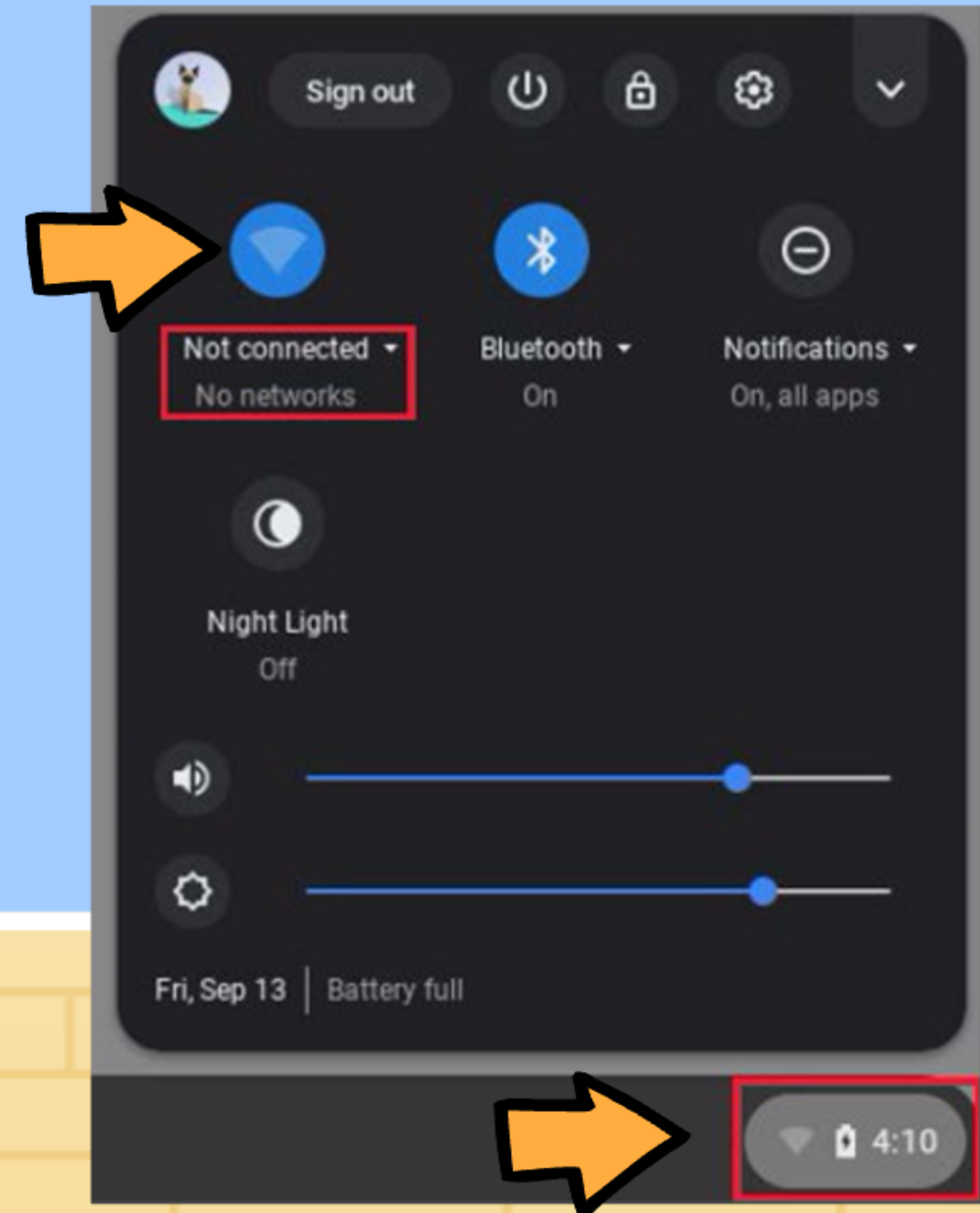


**Step 1:** Click the TIME ICON in the lower right corner to open the setting menu.

**Step 2:** Click on the WIFI ICON



Tip: If you see your Wi-Fi network name and a signal strength, your laptop is already connected to Wi-Fi.




### 3. Connect to your Internet

**Step 3:** A list of network options will appear. Select the network you would like to connect to.

**Step 4 (Optional):** If the Wi-Fi network you are trying to connect to requires a password, you will be prompted to enter a password.

Enter the password and click "Connect".

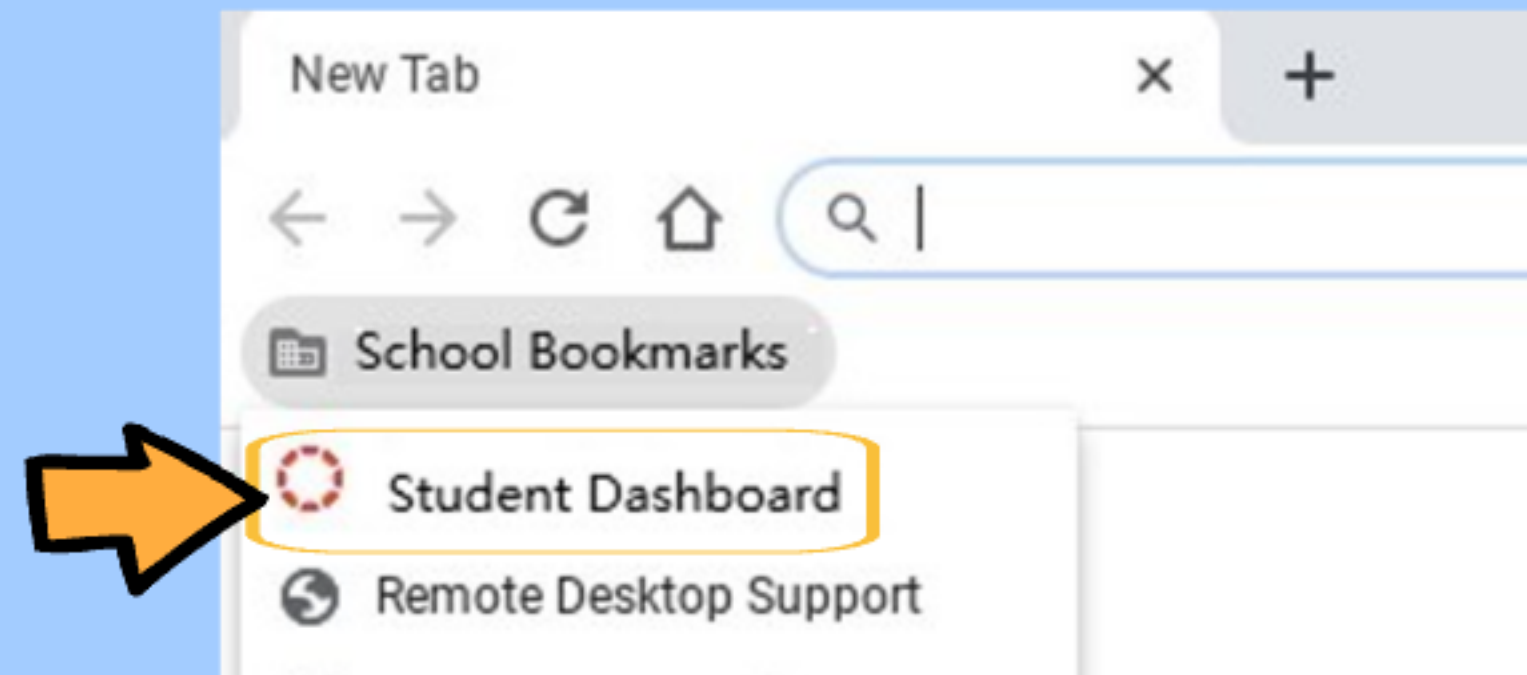
